

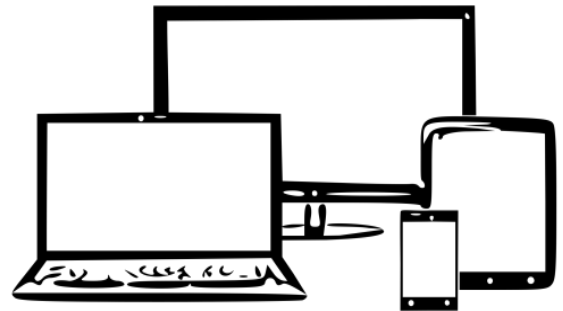
## Statewide Program for Purchasing Low Cost Refurbished Computers and Select iOS Devices

AzTAP has partnered with Achieve Human Services in Yuma, AZ and their "RefurbIT" program to offer special discount rates on their low-cost refurbished computers and select iOS devices for persons with disabilities and family members in their households.

**To qualify for this program**, you or a family member living in your home must

- (1) Have a disability; and
- (2) Be currently receiving at least **one** of the following state or federal assistance benefits (must provide proof with a copy of an award letter or card with name on it)

- AHCCCS/Medicaid
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (Section 8)
- Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHAEP)
- National School Lunch Program (Free Lunch Program)
- Social Security Disability Income (SSDI)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- State Children's Health Insurance Plan (SCHIP) / KidsCare
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Food
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- VA benefits



**Here is how the process works:** To view the sample computer pricing and to apply, go to the AT Reuse Page on the AzTAP website <http://aztap.org/at-reuse/achieve/>

You will need to complete and submit the simple online application.

After your application is submitted and benefits are verified, approved applicants will be given login information and instructions for purchasing the desired computer directly from RefurbIT.
